Development, testing, improvement, and further testing

Innovation is multifaceted at Hoefnagels Fire Safety. Every day our engineers research into the properties of new materials, the sturdiness of constructions and smarter control electronics.

Fire safety will always be the number one requirement for innovations, followed closely by customer demands. Further important aspects are improved application options, more efficient production and sustainability.

We make sure that products have been extensively tested before they are brought to the market. This is first done in-house using our own testing oven, in which we expose screens, shutters and doors to extreme conditions. If the products pass this test with flying colours, the test is redone life-size at one of the certified European testing institutes, where

they will be thoroughly examined. Only if the products once again pass successfully, they will receive a CE marking, after which they can be sold in Europe under stringent conditions.





Fire-resistant rolling screens

Our Firescreen® roller screen is made of a high-grade fire-resistant fabric. When the screen is in standby mode, the fire-resistant fabric takes up little space. Thanks to its compact dimensions and small installation space, it is a fantastic solution for buildings with an open structure, such as healthcare institutions, hospitals, schools, offices or theatres.

Smoke protection roller curtains

Smoke poses more danger than fire; it claims a higher amount of victims on a yearly basis. Smoke curtains from the Firescreen Smoke range – in combination with an extracting system – limit the spread of smoke.

Fire-resistant sliding doors

Thanks to their small installation dimensions, our sliding doors are commonly used as fire separations. Additionally, the Firelock® sliding door offers a unique evacuation possibility through the use of escape doors. In situations where the appearance of the door is a factor, the doors can be supplied with fire-resistant glass, stainless steel or stuccowork. A special version of this door combines fire and burglar resistance up to a RC4 rating, which is unique in the world.

Fire-resistant rolling shutters

Firelock® rolling shutters ensure hermetic sealing and fire compartmentation. This makes them perfect for conveyor belts in airports and production facilities. The system's smart electronics ensure that luggage or products on the conveyor belt do not obstruct sealing of the door. A battery package guarantees proper functioning of the shutters, even in the event of power outage.

Fire-resistant façades

In combination with fire-resistant glass, our steel frames create safe but at the same time aesthetic, transparent spaces that are especially suitable for the healthcare and education sectors, museums and other spaces in which people and architecture play a central role.

Control technology

Fire doors are just a small part of a fire safety system. Our control boxes are able to process the signals from the fire system with an extremely high degree of operational reliability and flexibility.

All products are being improved continuously. Many of our products are available in versions that are both fire- and burglar-resistant. You can find the most recent product characteristics on our website.



Supplementary products

Our products largely comprise the area of passive fire safety, the collective name for structural provisions that are used to protect building compartments from fire. This is the area Hoefnagels Fire Safety specialises in.

Fire doors and fire screens are developed, engineered and manufactured in-house. However, other components, such as conduits and constructions in walls, determine the level of passive fire safety in the end and therefore make up a substantial part of our product range.

Moreover, we work together with suppliers of active fire safety products. They focus more strongly on fire and smoke combating.
