If it does drag on a bit, grab a couple of stackable chairs or stools.

A place where people can meet

Design your office to cope with different types of working and give the corporate meeting culture an overhaul. You'll make meetings more effective, rewarding and something everyone can look forward to.

Take a look at how all the spaces available in the office could work for different types of meeting. The lounge near the entrance, for example. Put a screen in there and make it a place for hybrid meetings with others not physically in the office. A sit-stand table in the big conference rooms also facilitates quick reviews and more

informal 'mingle-meetings'. Standing up during a meeting has been shown to be more productive than long periods sitting down. Even the canteen can host a working lunch or quick catchups before and after lunch break. With the right decor, any area can do more.





← Work meetings: Once in a while, everyone has to roll up their sleeves and concentrate on the same task. That's when a good meeting table and a really comfortable chair you can sit in for hours are worth having. A movable planning board also helps everyone to understand the issues and arrive at a collective answer. (Pssst...don't forget to stretch your legs!)

→ Work meetings: The acoustics in a meeting room can make a difference to how long you can work effectively. A desk with a slightly softer linoleum surface cuts the noise of pens, coffee cups, etc. being put down.

Tips to create the best teamworking areas

Start by listing which teamworking areas you need, and where you want them placed around the office. Here are a few meetings your office may need space for:

Spontaneous meetings:

Take a look at the flow through the office premises. Where do most people pass most often during the day? That would be the perfect place for an inviting seating area, where it's possible to sit for a quick meeting. Sound-absorption in some form is a good idea to prevent disturbing others.

Online meetings:

Create multiple small spaces equipped for online hybrid meetings, with room for 2-4 people and a couple of others on jump seats. They'll be needed more than you think in future.

Big meetings:

A large room with plenty of table space and seating for up to 20 people is sometimes needed, but not always. You may want to consider furnishing a big meeting room with stackable chairs that can be moved away when not in use. Making the table height-adjustable provides better ergonomics and gives a varied working position for all types of get-togethers.

Informal meetings:

Good acoustics and a little more space are important here. For example: a mobile screen that can be moved around a table or a few armchairs signals that you don't want to be disturbed right now.

Work meetings:

Mobile planning boards are invaluable, letting you move the entire project idea wall to a teamworking area and park it where another group can bring in theirs too. Just try to avoid collisions!

Flexible meeting areas:

Sound-absorbent surfaces provide good acoustics while a screen makes it easy to show presentations or hold video conferences. The addition of a sofa or two gives more choice than just chairs. A room that avoids constraints, pure and simple.





A dedicated room

Can you dedicate an entire room at home for work? Or are you lucky enough to have your own studio space? Congratulations!








Working together is as easy as living together



How an hour spent emailing can give you a stronger back



Hand on heart, we do spend a lot of time sitting in the office. But apart from being able to work standing up instead, and even walking while you work, you can sit more actively.

New furniture and other equipment designed to keep your body moving makes work easier and improves your health. With an ergonomic Pilates ball, a balance stool or saddle chair, you can activate your back and pelvic muscles for example. Your posture will improve in line with your pelvis strengthening, giving you a more upright sitting posture. When the deeper muscles begin to work, they also burn more energy and calories as well as increasing your blood circulation. That in turn helps you think more clearly and become more productive.

Even more movement

You can also switch to something that takes movement to a whole new level for a little while each day. Using a treadmill or desk bike at your sit-stand desk makes 30 minutes of computer work into a half-hour slow walk or bike ride. Active chairs also relieve back problems by releasing tension in the back from an incorrect sitting position. Your body also becomes fitter and stronger.

Start gently

Remember that an active chair should only be used for a few hours a day initially, and can cause a little muscular stiffness. But once your body is used to it, you can use your active chair more and more, eventually reaching the stage where your conventional office chair is just an ornament. By getting a range of different active furniture items for the office, you and your colleagues can take turns, varying your working positions during the day. So say goodbye to sedentary work, and hello to the new, active office!

In large offices, many people often work in several different teams. That means a mix of fixed workstations with room for 3-8 people, who need to be able to work together. There also have to be places for working alone productively.






Like a community in miniature

Lots of people are moving around a big office every day. So planning has to take into account workstations, traffic and job satisfaction.

To be able to design a big, highly-functional office, you need to ask a few questions. Where will the main traffic flow and where will be calmer? How can you create healthy workstations where it's easy to meet and swap ideas in an open plan office? Where should you put places to work in peace or conduct a discreet conversation? That way you are prepared and have everything to hand but it can be put away during lunchtime. Remember that the lighting has to be discreet during breaks but effective when work starts again.
