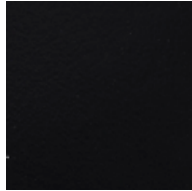

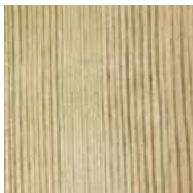

Recycled aluminium

Aluminium has very good corrosion resistance. When exposed to air, the material develops a thin oxide layer, which provides protection. Smelting recycled aluminium minimises energy consumption and the metal can be recycled over and over again.

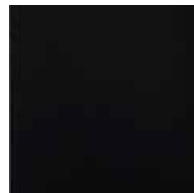

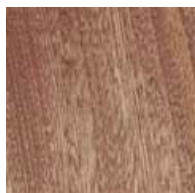

Pine

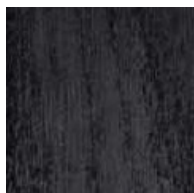
Byarums Bruk uses slow-grown pine from northern Sweden, a mature and resinous wood that is resistant to rot.

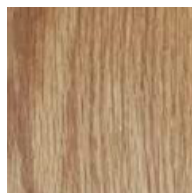
Black glazed mahogany

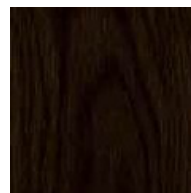
Mahogany is a weather-resistant, hard and rot-resistant wood, making it particularly suitable for outdoor use.
