Edges

A vital part of the kitchen design is the edge profile of the worktop. There are numerous different edges to choose from. Your kitchen designer or manufacturer can offer you guidance in selecting the perfect edge detail for your kitchen worktop.

Thickness

The standard thicknesses of a Lundhs Real Stone worktop are 2 cm or 3 cm. Both thicknesses offer the same level of durability. The choice is yours.

Sizes

Lundhs Real Stone slabs are available in different sizes. Your fabricator/showroom will help you choose the best size available for your kitchen. Please note that the maximum size of a slab is 330 x 180 cm. This is due to the capacity and set up of the processing machines that cut the blocks of stone into slabs. If your worktop or island requires a larger piece, two slabs can be joined together. A skilled fabricator will be able to join the pieces together beautifully.





Details that matter

Most kitchens will require a sink installation. There are a number of options offered by different suppliers regarding both materials and design. Here is an overview of the most common installation methods and what kind of finished look they will achieve in your kitchen.



INSET SINK

Inset sink is a conventional method of installation. The sink centre is simply inserted from above into a prepared cut out space in your worktop.



FLUSHMOUNT SINK

With this installation method, the sink and the worktop form a level surface – which is perfectly flush and has no joints to get in the way.

UNDERMOUNT SINK

The sink is installed under the worktop, providing a functional extension of the surface and an easy-to-clean area. It also offers the possibility to create draining grooves on one or both sides of the sink if desired.





RECESSED UNDERMOUNT

The installation of a recessed undermount sink is almost the same as for a normal undermount sink. The difference is that the visible stone edge inside the sink is thinner than the worktop. This installation is only possible on worktops that are at least 3 cm thick.



INTEGRATED SINK

If you like the idea of your sink being the same material as your worktop, then an integrated design is a good option, making the sink and worktop into one seamless unit.

Hobs

The hob is a vital part of the kitchen – here are the most common options for installation.



INSET HOB The worktop is simply inserted from above into a prepared cut out space in your worktop.



FLUSHMOUNT HOB

With this installation method, the cooktop and the worktop form a level surface – which is perfectly flush and easy to maintain.

A GORGEOUS BLEND OF NATURAL MATERIALS

A stunning combination of natural materials, the oak and stone in this kitchen complement each other perfectly to create a contemporary yet delicate scheme. Hexagon tiles in a range of surface finishes in the same stone have been used on the kitchen splashback, reflecting the light differently and creating a unique design statement.
