Window joinery is a noble art with roots in history, not least in Småland, inherited for generations. Glass and wood are in the region's DNA.



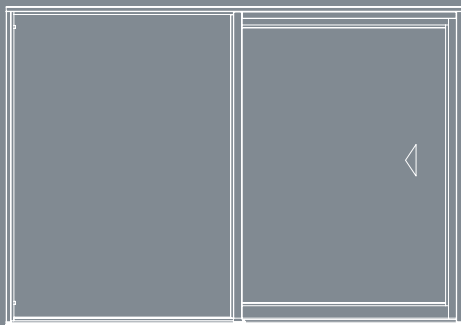

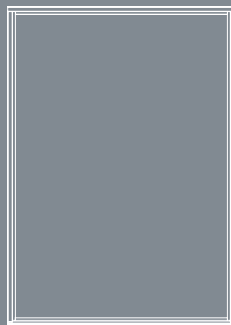
We manufacture doors, folding doors, windows and sliding doors made of wood and glass with an advanced glide and lifting function. Wood is combined with innovative materials. Our glass partitions can be equipped with sunshade, electronic dimming and motor drive.

The sliding doors roll on ball bearings. The slide and lift function is easy to operate and allows the heavy glass partitions to run easily and silently. Angled profiles seal wood against wood when locking.

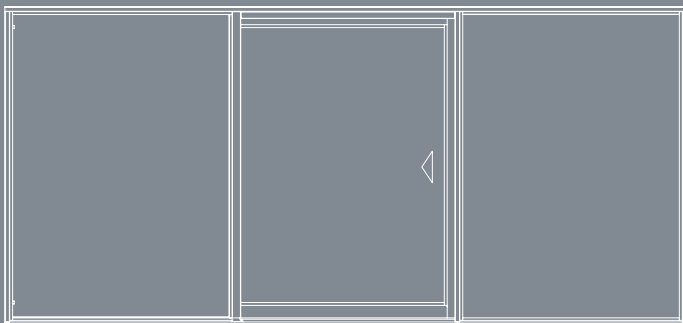

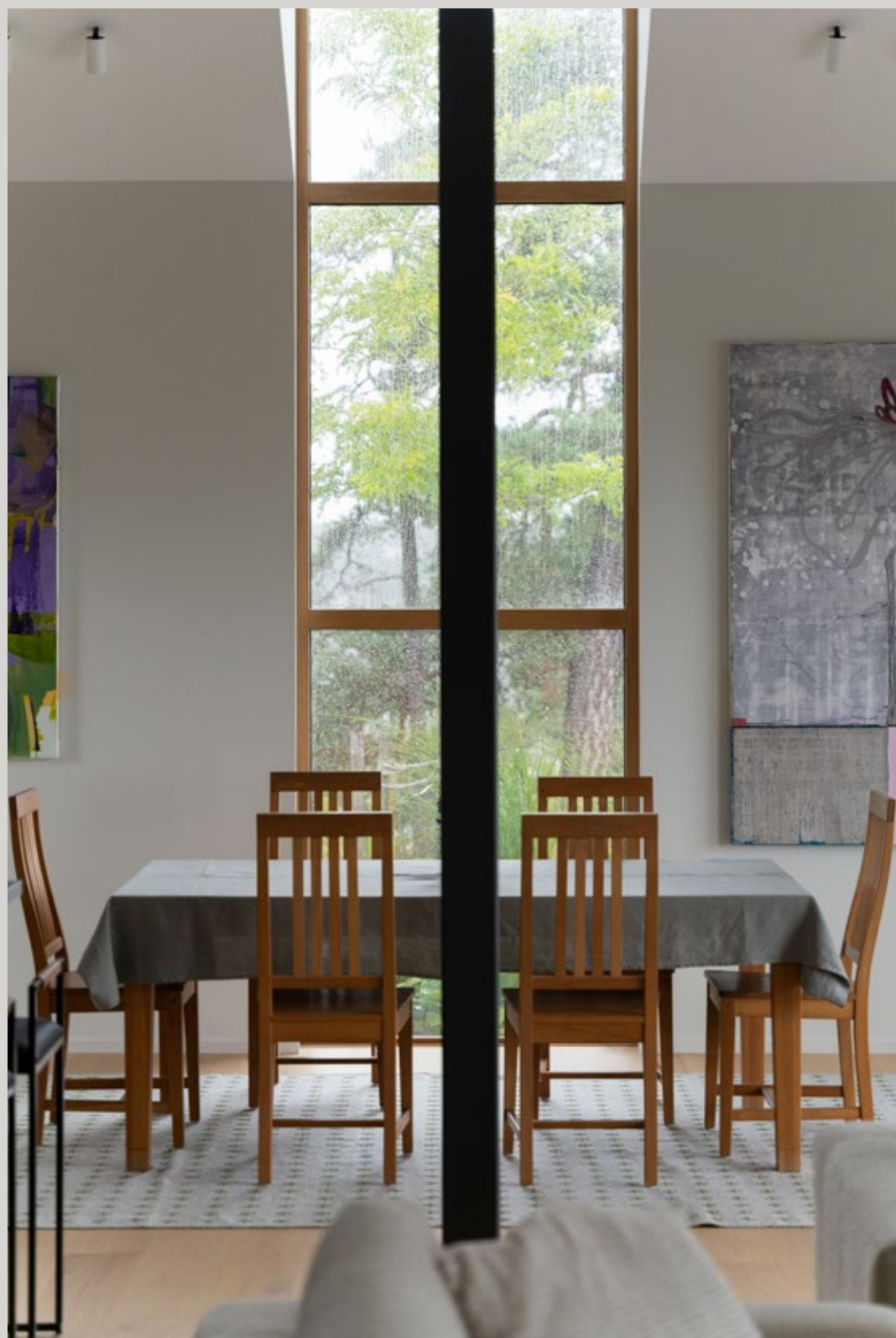












Entire glass partitions can be load bearing. Something Le Corbusier could only dream of. His open floor plans and ribbon windows in the façade required pillars of concrete.
