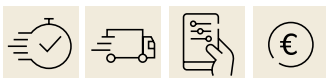

MSG CAMPUS - NURSERY SCHOOL MERSEBURG | GERMANY

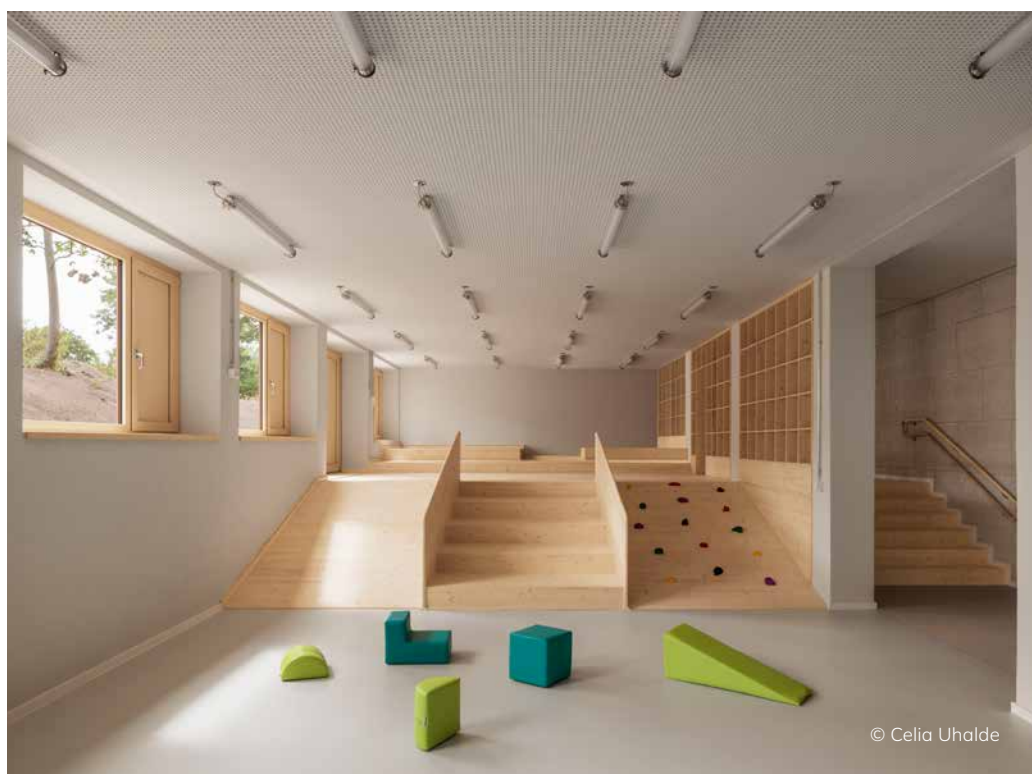
Making an impact

A former telephone exchange on the campus of Merseburg University of Applied Sciences was converted by the Halle Student Services Association into a nursery for 42 children aged 0 to 6. A cathedral-like room in the basement, lit from one side, was ideal as a playroom for the children.

The existing building structure also proved to be remarkably flexible for accommodating group rooms, a kitchen and washroom facilities, which were equipped with F5 single-lever mixers with integrated thermostatic scald protection.

Ready, Steady, Go!

As Lübeck's largest indoor swimming pool, the St. Lorenz Sports Pool has been the top venue for swimming competitions and elite sports since 1974. Following extensive modernisation at the end of 2022, the pool reopened its doors in January 2025. Swimming enthusiasts can enjoy a premium stainless steel pool complete with a spiral bridge, an additional training pool, a lovingly designed area for toddlers, and a fully refurbished interior.

For the renovation, stainless steel shower panels from the F5 line were installed thanks to their high degree of prefabrication and easy surface-mounted installation.

These panels feature electronically controlled thermostatic mixers with active scald protection. In the washroom area, the opto-electronically controlled F5E-Mix impresses with its elegant design. The clearly visible infrared sensor detects approaching hands and activates the water flow. When hands leave the sensor area, the water flow stops automatically, ensuring no water is wasted unnecessarily.

Multiple construction phases completed

The extreme conditions present in a prison place special demands on planning and product solutions. For this reason, the Nuremberg prison chose sanitary solutions from KWC Professional for its entrance and exit building. Among the installations were robust sanitary combinations made of durable stainless steel. During the renovation of the shower facilities in another construction phase, special wall-mounted fittings from the HEAVY-DUTY range were used. From the outside, only the piezo button embedded in the stainless steel cover plate, secured with safety screws, is visible. Active scald protection is provided by the integrated thermostat. This electronic tap solution can be centrally monitored and controlled via the AQUA 3000 open water management system.
