We generate **no waste** when processing our defective parts. They are reground in-house and reintroduced into the production cycle. By using recycled material in our production cycle – accounting for over 90% of our product range – **we produce nine times less CO₂** than we would if we used virgin material. By manufacturing with recycled material, we consume **nine times less non-renewable energy** than we would with virgin material.



We must **work together to fulfil this ecological responsibility** and act as guardians of a **sustainable approach for future generations**. Ultimately, this requires actively listening to **global concerns regarding water management**.

Through our product ranges, we are committed to **combating soil sealing**. Our ambition aligns with that of the Climate and Resilience Acts, which have set the **"Net Zero Land Sealing"** target, promoting rainwater infiltration and limiting disruptions to the water cycle.

This year, our company has once again been awarded the **MORE label**, created by the Federation of Plastics and Composites (MOBilised for REcycling), which certifies that we use 100% recycled plastic, sourced from the textile sector, in our production.
