Hee Welling's philosophy is expressed in the simple geometries and spirited contours of his products, focusing on simple useful products that pursue an honest, careful use of materials. Geometrical shapes and playful contours reoccur within his designs, while ornamentation is seen as superfluous to his work. Educated at the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts, Welling follows in the footsteps of Denmarks' great designers. His work has been awarded several prizes, including – the Bo Bedre Design Award (Denmark), the Good Design Award (USA), the New Danish Art Foundation (Denmark). Having already designed multiple pro-ducts for Icons, in 2020 the 4T System was launched, one of his most significant and complex products to date.

"The whole concept of making a system that can work as walls, as dividers, as booths, is really interesting. I think zoning is a common challenge in the market right now, that we needed to find an adaptable solution for. The way people are travelling, moving around and using environments, has changed a lot for office spaces, and this system helps support these changes. A few years ago, the workplace was quite 'copy and paste', from one office to another. Right now, people want to put their own personal touch on it, a more 'homey' feeling of warmth – creating a place where they really like to be, rather than somewhere which looks very industrial."






