


Boris Berlin's design philosophy is simple: "Good design is always international." Emigrating to Copenhagen in the 1980s, Boris has continually reinterpreted the principles of Danish Modernism, using it to infuse global perspectives into his work. This philosophy is fundamental to today's international workplace – ensuring spaces transcend cultural boundaries, combining the best of all worlds to create something uniquely compelling.

Berlin continues to nurture his design practice by exhibiting globally and guest lecturing at multiple universities. He has

been the recipient of the Red Dot, German Design, Good Design awards, and numerous others. Additionally, his products are included in the collections of MOMA, the Indianapolis Museum of Art, and the Design Museum Denmark.

"When I started to develop my ideas for the Ekko, I wanted the product to be organic in line and shape, but within the interior of the product to still allow it to fit within angular or confined architectural spaces. The result was a rectangular, tight shape on the outside and a plush, organically shaped interior that supported the user."


